




SCHOOL BUS SAFETY





To ensure safe transportation to school it is necessary to follow some very important rules.

The bus driver is the person in charge on the bus so you must obey his/her instructions.


Be on time! You have to be at your bus stop at least 5 minutes ahead of time. At the stop you must stand back from the side of the road and never run towards the bus. You must walk.





Before crossing the road you should wait for the driver to signal you. You must always be visible to the driver.






It is very important to board the school bus in a single file without pushing or shoving and holding on to the hand rail.





Once onboard the bus, you must take your seat immediately, sit down and stay seated until you arrive.





The aisle must always be kept clear.





There should be no food or drink on the bus.

Talk quietly with your friends. Do not shout.






You must not throw objects inside or outside the bus.






You must keep your hands and your head inside the bus at all times.





There is a danger zone surrounding the bus which you have to stay away from.






You must wait until the bus has come to a full stop before you stand up to leave.

You must be sure to have all of your belongings with you before leaving. As you exit the bus it's important to hold on to the hand rail.
